

## Become a Children's University Activity Centre



As a school or other educational body you will probably already have a range of activities that children can attend out of school hours - these could be included as Children's University modules. Some examples of activity centres that already exist are:

- Summer Learning Festival activities
- Music Service Friary Centre County Ensembles
- Cardiff Key Skills Recognition Scheme activities
- Learning Centre Activities (High and Primary Schools)
- Study Support and extra-curricular activities in schools
- Dragon Sport scheme
- 5x60 activities
- Llanover Hall activities
- Storey Arms activities
- Leisure Centre Activities

Schools and organisations who have their out of school hours learning programme accredited under the scheme go through the following process:

- The school or educational organisation contacts the CU co-ordinator
- The organisation completes the Children's University Application Form
- The Children's University co-ordinator will send a starter pack which will include the Credit Update Form.
- The school or organisation deliver the activity
- On completion of the activity the Credit Update Form is sent to the CU co-ordinator.
- The co-ordinator then banks the credits against each student's record

The co-ordinator regularly informs the school and pupils via a bank statement report and notifies them of any pending award.
